

Linhas Aereas de Mocambique (LAM) - Embraer ERJ-190

Date of Loss: 29th November 2013

According to reports a Linhas Aereas de Mocambique (LAM) Embraer ERJ-190, which was performing a flight from Maputo (Mozambique) to Luanda (Angola) with 27 passengers and 6 crew on board was in flight at 38,000 feet over northern Botswana when the aircraft suddenly began to descend at about 6000 feet per minute until radar and radio contact was lost with the aircraft at around 11:30AM local time.

The wreckage of the aircraft was found crashed and burnt out the following day (30th) in the Bwabwata National Park, Namibia.

There were no survivors amongst the 27 passengers and 6 crew.
